



How to use your key

Put the key all the way into the lock cylinder and turn. If the lock doesn't open, take the key out of the cylinder and repeat the process more slowly.

When the key is put into the lock, the lock cylinder generates all the electric energy needed by the electronics in the cylinder and the key. If the key is put into the lock too quickly, the cylinder will remain in the locked position.

Why doesn't my lock open?

If the lock sometimes doesn't open, the reason is usually that you are putting the key in too quickly. Then the lock doesn't have time to recognise the rights that are programmed into your key. Put the key in again at a calm and even speed.



N.B. THE ILOQ KEY SHOULD NOT BE USED FOR OTHER PURPOSES THAN THAT IN THESE INSTRUCTIONS. FOREIGN OBJECTS AND OTHER KEYS MUST NOT BE PUT INTO THE LOCK CYLINDER.

THE KEY MUST NOT BE CHANGED IN ANY WAY.
